formflex synthetic

Formflex is a range of undercast padding bandages that are designed to be compatible with both synthetic and non synthetic casting materials. They are easy to apply and remove, and deliver improved patient comfort and protection.

- Formflex Synthetic is made from 100% polyester which gives low water retention properties to help speed up cast drying.
- The construction of the fabric is designed to ease removal of the cast by limiting penetration of the cast material into the padding.
- It is extra soft and highly conformable to deliver a smooth finish.
- It is strong yet easy to tear and has a useful degree of self adherence for convenient application.
- It provides cushioning to protect vulnerable areas.
- It withstands compression.
- It is also available in a steam sterilised format for convenience.

Technical details

Fibre: 100% Polyester (including 12% Co-Polymer)
Fabric Weight: 80gsm
Thickness: 3mm (single layer uncompressed)
Roll Length: 2.7m
Standard Widths: 5cm, 7.5cm, 10cm, 15cm, 20cm.
Standard packaging: Compression packed in recyclable materials, for savings in transport and storage. Each bandage is individually wrapped in a printed sleeve. 6 bandages are placed in a polythene bag with an information insert which is batch coded.



Sterile packaging:



The bandage is wrapped in a sterile field paper and sealed within an easy peel pouch. The specified number of bandages are packed into a corrugated cardboard carton. A label detailing the contents, storage conditions, lot number and expiry date is attached to two sides of the outer carton.

Sterilisation:

The bandages are sterilised by moist heat (Steam) in accordance with BS EN ISO 17665-1:2006 and are labelled as Sterile in accordance with EN 556-1.
